Privacy Policy

This policy outlines the Co-operative's approach to protecting the privacy of our members and visitors to our website. The Co-operative understands that privacy is important to you and fully intends to protect that privacy.

The Co-operative is subject to the National Privacy Principles (NPP's) that are contained in the Privacy Act 1988.

1. General Policy

The Co-operative respects the privacy of individuals and does not release personal information. However, in response to a legal requirement, in the case of an emergency or in exceptional circumstances the Co-operative's Coordinator may, at his or her discretion authorise the release of the personal information.

In other situations the collection, use and disclosure of personal information is governed by the Co-operative's privacy policy.

2. Collection

2.1 Existing Customers

For people who ask for our information and services, the Co-operative may collect information about you such as your name, contact information, including your email address, (if appropriate) and mailing address. This information is necessary in order to provide people with our information and services and to manage our customer relationships.

2.2 Information gathered by this site's technology

The Co-operative may make a record of your visit and log your visit for statistical and operational purposes. Such information may include your server address, domain name, IP address, the date and time of your visit, pages accessed, documents downloaded, previous site visited and the type of browser used.

2.3 E-mail

If you send us an e-mail message, we will record your e-mail address. We will only use your e-mail address for the purpose for which it was provided. We will not use your e-mail address for any other purposes, including adding it to any mailing list without your express approval.

2.4 Cookies

Cookies are small files of information that save and retrieve information about your visit to our site. If you do not wish information to be gathered on a cookie, it is possible to disable the acceptance of cookies by your web browser. If you want to do this, you should contact your ISP. If this site uses a cookie to deliver contents we think will interest you, the cookie may also be used for authentication.

2.5 Links

If this site contains a link to another site, we are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such other sites.

3. Use

Personal information that you supply through this site will only be used for the purpose for which you have provided it, and to assist us to conduct our service. This may include analysing information obtained on the site to determine the effectiveness of the site and to modify the site to improve the service that it provides.

4. Disclosure

We will not disclose your personal information to a third party except in accordance with this notice and the Co-operative's privacy policy.
